“In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one.”

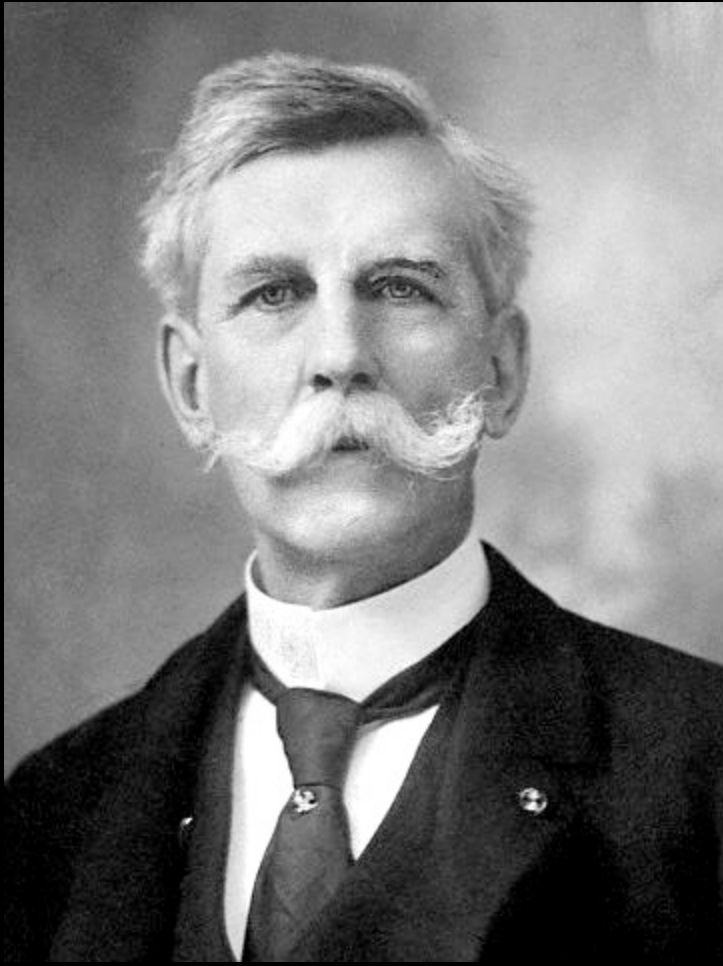


The Roman shield mentioned by Paul refers not to one that protects an individual, but one that interlocks with other shields to defend many soldiers.
